

The Lodge and East Wing have oil-fired central heating and hot water. They have separate boilers situated outside with hot water cylinders in both properties.

The timers are situated in the respective kitchens. On your arrival they will be set to come on twice – early morning and afternoon. This also applies to the hot water.

If you wish to have the heating on outside the set times press the 'extra hour' button on the programmer. Likewise for hot water.

Please do not alter any settings.

If a particular room is too hot, adjustment can be made by way of the thermostatic valve on each radiator.
